RE: Affiliation between Czech Society for Clinical Neurophysiology and *Clinical Neurophysiology*

It gives me great pleasure to confirm our offer to affiliate the journal 'Clinical Neurophysiology' (the 'Journal') owned by the International Federation of Clinical Neurophysiology (the 'Federation') and published by Elsevier Ireland Ltd (the 'Publisher') with the Czech Society for Clinical Neurophysiology (the 'Society'). Set out below are the terms and conditions relating to this affiliation, commencing as of 01 January 2011.


Ownership and Rights

The Federation shall be, as between the parties, the owner of all rights in the Journal, including without limitation the trademark rights and copyright. The Society grants the Publisher the right to indicate that it is associated with the Journal. The notice: Affiliated with the Czech Society for Clinical Neurophysiology, along with the seal or other trade mark representing the Society, as designated by the Society, may be printed on the cover of, and in other prominent locations within, the Journal. The Publisher may use the name and description of the Society and may also mention its collaboration with the Society in connection with its promotion and distribution of the Journal. The trade name, seal and other identifying trademarks of the Society will continue to be owned by the Society.

Editorial, Promotion, Production, and Distribution

The Society agrees that the current Aims and Scope of the Journal as set forth in Annex 1 are consistent with the Society's purpose. With respect to all matters regarding editorial operations, promotion, production, and distribution of the Journal, the Publisher retains all responsibilities, duties, and rights. Each party will identify a staff member to be the principal point of contact for the other with respect to the Journal.

Regarding the appointment of editors and members to the board; the editing, acceptance and refereeing of papers; and relations with authors, subscribers and advertisers, the Society acknowledges that the Federation in consultation with the Publisher retains all responsibilities, duties and rights.



Member Subscriptions

The Society will be charged a fixed fee of 1,625 EURO for the online-only access to the Journal for all its members. That fixed fee will be applicable for the years 2011-12.

Thereafter this fee may be revised by the Publisher in consultation with the Society at the time of contract renewal, also in the event that the Publisher wishes to increase the frequency of the Journal or increase the total number of pages for any given year beyond page budget set forth herein.

All other subscription rates of the journal for future years shall be determined by the Publisher in its sole discretion.

The subscription year shall run from January to December. Any Member wishing to subscribe to back print issues of the Journal will be entitled to purchase individual issues at the standard back copy rate as provided by the Regional Sales Office of the Publisher.

During the term of this Agreement, the Society will receive a complimentary subscription to the Journal for office use. On request, in the January following the end of a subscription year, the Society will provide the Publisher the number of registered Members to the Society.

Society Responsibilities

The Society will use its best efforts to promote the Journal to the Members and to the relevant scientific discipline, will endeavour to stimulate the submission of papers of the highest professional standard, and will include regular prominent announcements of the online access to the Journal for Members in the Society newsletter, website and other publicity material, free of charge.


The Society agrees to provide the Publisher, free of charge, with complementary registration for one attendee together with an exhibit booth for the Journal and related products at meetings, conferences or exhibitions that may be organized by the Society.

Publication and Advertisement

All English-language abstracts from meetings organised by the Society may be published as e-matter to the journal, i.e. all abstracts will not appear in a print issue but in the online version of the journal only at no additional charge. The Publisher will also during the term make available up to 1 page within three issues to the Society, free-of-charge, for publicising Society events and information. The Publisher and the Society will set up reciprocal links between the website of the Journal and the home page of the Society's website.

Term of Agreement

This Agreement will run for an initial term of 2 years from 2011 through 2012. Thereafter it will be renewed automatically for 5 year periods unless either the Society or the Publisher gives notice to the contrary at least nine (9) months before the end of the period that it wishes to end this Agreement. However, either the Society or the Publisher may also end the Agreement prior to the end of a relevant period if the other party has failed to perform any of its important obligations (as described in this Agreement) after being notified of such failure and without any reasonably acceptable resolution within 45 days of such notice, and the Publisher may terminate this Agreement upon six (6) months written notice in the event it decides to cease publication of the Journal. The Publisher may, without prior written consent of the Society, assign this Agreement to an affiliate or subsidiary or if it sells or transfers all or substantially all of its assets.



In the event of expiration or termination of this Agreement, all obligations on the part of the Publisher shall cease, as shall the obligation to provide Member subscriptions at the rates described herein.

General

This Agreement and its construction, validity and effect shall be governed by the laws of The Netherlands, without giving effect to the choice of law provisions thereof, regardless of the place of its execution or performance.



Annex 1

Aims and Scope of the Journal

Clinical Neurophysiology is the official journal of the [International Federation of Clinical Neurophysiology](#), [Italian Clinical Neurophysiology Society](#), and the [Brazilian Society of Clinical Neurophysiology](#).

It is dedicated to fostering research and disseminating information on all aspects of Clinical Neurophysiology, both normal and abnormal. The journal aims at publishing scholarly reports on human physiology and pathophysiology of both the central and the peripheral nervous system. The journal is interested in manuscripts reporting data on integrated neuroimaging of central nervous functions including, but not limited to, functional MRI, MEG, EEG, PET and other aspects of neuroimaging. Electromyography, motor control and somatosensory physiopathology are covered by the journal, as well as evoked potentials with special emphasis on studies of cognitive functions. Studies on animals and technical notes must have clear relevance and applicability to humans.
